

What You Need to Know About Overdrafts and Overdraft Fees

An overdraft occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. We have standard overdraft practices, that may be available with your account if certain criteria are met.
- 2. We also offer two <u>overdraft protection plans</u>; a link to a TCU share account and a line of credit. These plans may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more, please contact us at (603) 889-2470.

This notice explains Courtesy Pay, our standard overdraft practice.

What are the Courtesy Pay practices that may be available with your account?

We <u>do authorize</u> and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- · Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic Clearing House (ACH) transactions, such as automatic bill payment
- Recurring transactions using your debit card number

We <u>do not authorize</u> and pay overdrafts for the following type of transaction:

- · ATM transactions
- · Point of Sale transactions using a PIN
- · Checks cashed at our teller windows

We do not authorize and pay overdrafts for the following type of transaction unless you ask us to (see below):

Non-PIN one time debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we <u>do not authorize</u> and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be <u>declined</u>.

What if I want Triangle Credit Union to authorize and pay overdrafts on my non-PIN one time debit card transactions?

What fees will I be charged if Triangle Credit Union pays my overdraft?

Under our standard overdraft practices:

- We will charge you a fee of \$30 each time we pay an overdraft
- There is no limit on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account
